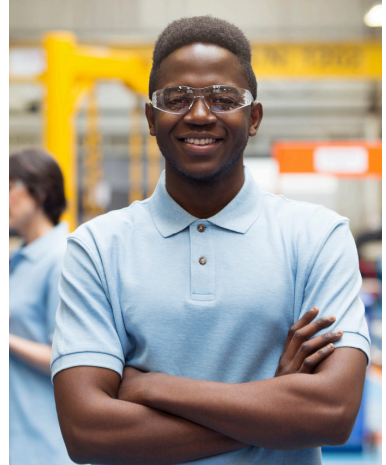

ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

The Access to Higher Education Diploma is nationally recognised as a university entrance qualification.

This programme is designed for adult learners who come from a broad age range and varied backgrounds. If you progress onto university then your fees are usually non-repayable for your access course*.

A ROUTE TO UNIVERSITY STUDY IN JUST 9 MONTHS!

The Access to Higher Education Diploma course has completely transformed the lives of thousands of adults. If you do not have a full Level 3 qualification, here is an opportunity



to return to study and achieve a nationally recognised qualification. The aim of the course is to provide you with a route into higher education at university or college. Former students have gone on to higher education courses at both our own University Centre Isle of Wight and elsewhere, showing that the course is successfully preparing students for the next stage in their education.

The qualification is a full-time course equivalent of two to three A Levels and takes 9 months to complete.

Many students who study Access to Higher Education Diploma use the government's Advanced Learner Loan initiative to fund it. This means there are no up-front fees or credit checks. If you go on to study at university you don't repay your Access to HE loan.

These courses are offered FREE of charge to anyone who does not already have a GCSE or O Level at grade 4/C or equivalent, ensuring that everyone, regardless of their employment status, can advance their education.

For adult learners seeking to study independently our structured programs ensure that everyone can fit these essential studies into their schedules. Additionally, for those requiring language support, our English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) courses range from Beginner to Level 2, aimed at enhancing your English communication skills through speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

We offer a comprehensive range of English and maths courses tailored to meet the needs of every learner, regardless of their life commitments such as work or family. GCSEs in English and maths are crucial for accessing higher education and are often a prerequisite for various job applications. If you haven't yet achieved a grade of A–C or 4 or above, or if you've never taken these GCSEs, our educational programs are designed to support you.

A range of FREE**, subsidised and full cost, part time courses that will enhance both your career prospects and performance within your current role

CMI Award in Management and Leadership (Level 5) 7 Weeks

The CMI qualifications are aimed at practicing or aspiring managers. The training on these courses can help you to develop the skill set required to manage people and organisations and help on your path to becoming a future leader.

Creative Industries

Certificate in Creative Media Skills (Level 2) 30 Weeks

October - Tuesdays, 09:00-12:15

This qualification gives you the opportunity to develop technical Creative Media skills through self-evaluation, practice and review. You will develop the transferable skills needed to progress to further education and employment, for example in communication, planning and managing projects and creative problem solving.

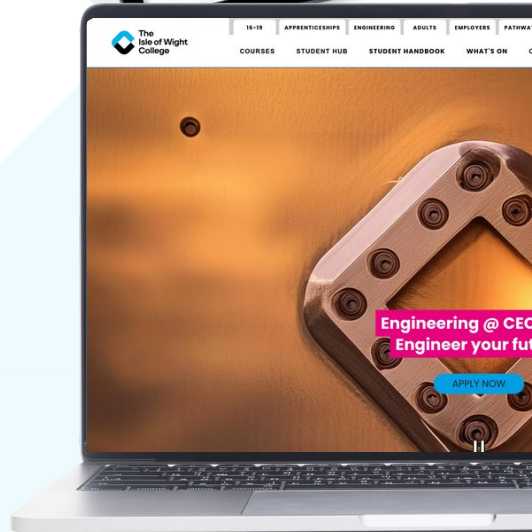
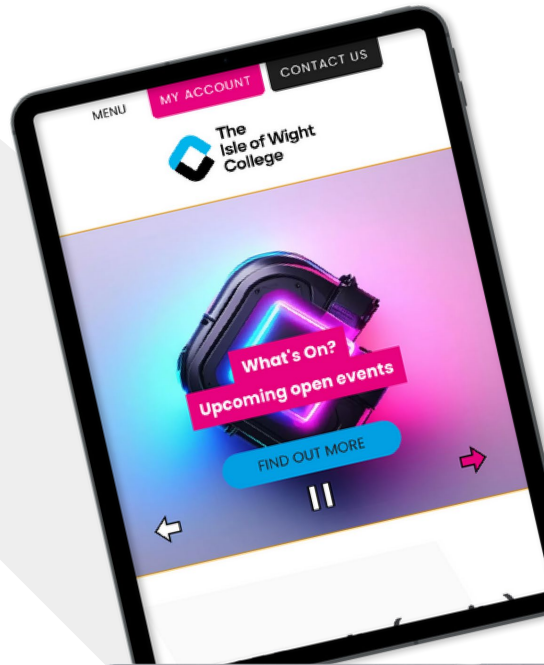
