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## EMPLOYERS – ARE YOU READY?

The Department for Education is introducing industry placements as a new way to give learners on Level 3 technical education courses the opportunity to put their skills and knowledge into practice, while developing an awareness of working life.

Placements involve 45 – 60 day placement (minimum 315 hours) in a role with a host employer. Students will already be equipped with the relevant basic skills needed to build on during their time on placement.

Industry placements will play a significant role in the new T Level option for young people. These are two-year technical programmes designed with input from employers.

### GREAT OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL

Industry placements benefit not just the learner, but the employer too:

- ❖ Bring new ideas and energy into your business
- ❖ Give current employees opportunities to gain skills coaching and mentoring
- ❖ Address any current and future skills shortages in your industry
- ❖ Introduce you to new talent, for potential recruitment opportunities in the future.
- ❖ Inspire a new generation of employees, ready to join your industry.

### WE WOULD ASK EMPLOYERS TO PROVIDE

- ❖ A minimum 45 day work placement (315 hours)
- ❖ A dedicated member of staff responsible for the learner
- ❖ A safe working environment
- ❖ Opportunities to develop their technical skills within industry
- ❖ Hold regular meeting with the student and provide constructive feedback
