Re: Return to on site provision from Monday 8 March

Dear

I hope you and your families are keeping safe and well. I am sure you will be aware of the government's announcement that schools and colleges should resume face to face teaching from **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March**.

I am pleased to confirm that the Isle of Wight College, including CECAMM, will resume timetabled classes from this date. All students should resume attending college on their normal scheduled days during this week.

The college will circulate further details during the course of next week (1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> March) on what students will need to know when they return. This will include details of voluntary COVID-19 testing which will be available and other health and safety measures that will be in place.

The exception to the above arrangements will be those students who have been notified by the NHS that they are clinically extremely vulnerable and have been asked to shield at home until at least 31<sup>st</sup> March. For these students separate arrangements will be made to enable you to continue online learning until the government guidance changes. If you have recently been notified by the NHS that you have been added to this list please can you inform the college by emailing [info@iwcollege.ac.uk](mailto:info@iwcollege.ac.uk) so we can put in place arrangements for you to continue to study at home.

Myself and all the staff are very much looking forward to welcoming you back on campus. Everyone at college will be here to help you to achieve your goals and to take full advantage of future opportunities, as we hopefully return to some form of normality during the summer and beyond.
